## Munster Juvenile PRO Report 2018

## "If you fail to prepare, you're prepared to fail"

2018 has been another hugely successful year for Munster Athletics with our athletes excelling in National competitions and on International teams throughout the year in a wide range of events. Some of the highlights & our best results are below -

- Two Munster athletes, **Miriam Daly, Carrick-On-Suir A.C.** and **Sophie Meredith, St. Mary's A.C. Limerick** competed at the World Youth Olympic Games in Buenos Aires in October. Daly finished 13<sup>th</sup> overall in the 400mH with Meredith placing 10<sup>th</sup> overall in the Long Jump.
- The World U/20 T&F Championships took place in Tampere, Finland from 10th to 15th July 2018. <u>5</u> athletes were selected to represent Munster on the Irish team with Ciara Neville, Emerald A.C. winning a silver medal as part of the Irish Women's 4 x 100m Relay team. The Munster team selected was Ciara Neville, Emerald A.C. (100m, 200m & 4 x 100m), Conor Morey, Leevale A.C. (4 x 100m), Darragh McElhinney, Bantry A.C. (5km), Jo Keane, Ennis Track A.C. (800m) & Orla O'Connor, Waterford A.C. (10km Walk).
- The European U/18 Track & Field Championships took place in Gyor, Hungary from 5th to 8th July 2018. <u>6</u> athletes represented Munster on the Irish team Ciara Kennelly, Killarney Valley A.C. (High Jump), Sophie Meredith, St. Mary's A.C. Limerick (Long Jump), Miriam Daly, Carrick-On-Suir A.C. (400mH), Sophie O'Sullivan, Ballymore Cobh A.C. (800m), Brian Lynch, Old Abbey A.C. (Decathlon) & Conor Morey, Leevale A.C. (100m). Our only medal winner was Sophie O'Sullivan who won a super silver medal in the 800m. Having easily progressed through her heat in 2.12.33 and Semi-Final in 2.07.95, O'Sullivan went on to win silver in 2.06.05 behind GB athlete Keely Hodgkinson who won in a new CR of 2.04.84.
- At the *Celtic Games International* in Grangemouth Stadium, Scotland in August, a total of <u>21</u> athletes from Munster competed on the day having <u>17</u> podium finishes (3 1<sup>st</sup> places, 8 2<sup>nd</sup> places & 6 3<sup>rd</sup> places).
- The Celtic International Cross Country took place in conjunction with the Antrim International Cross Country in Greenmount on Saturday 6th January 2018 with <u>10</u> Munster athletes on the Irish teams. Top 3 finishes were recorded by **Aimee Hayde, Newport A.C., Stephanie Cotter, West Muskerry A.C.** & **Paul Hartnett, Midleton A.C.**
- The SIAB Schools Cross Country International was held in Wollaton Park, Nottingham on Saturday 24th March 2018. <u>6</u> Munster athletes were selected to compete for Ireland Junior Girls Emma Landers, Pobalscoil na Trionoide Youghal Shauna McCarthy, PS Inbhear Sceine Kenmare Intermediate Girls Niamh O'Mahony, Presentation Tralee Tara Ramasawmy, Presentation Waterford Junior Boys Luke Griffin, St. Flannan's College Ennis Intermediate Boys Thomas Connolly, Christian Brothers College Cork.
- The SIAB Schools U/17 Track & Field International took place in Grangemouth Stadium, Scotland on Saturday 21st July 2018 with <u>22</u> Munster athletes taking part & bringing home 4 individual medals in total (2 silver & 2 bronze), and 3 Relay medals (3 silver). Ciara Sheehy, St. Mary's Charleville, the Irish Girls' team Captain, took home silver in the Shot Putt with a throw of 14.84m with Niamh O'Mahony, Presentation Tralee also winning silver in the 3000m in a time of 9.52.27. Niamh also won the Sean Nyhan medal for the Best Irish Performance on the day. Bronze medals were won by Megan Lenihan, Hazelwood College in the Girls Discus (38.98m) & Orla Coffey, St. Angela's Cork in the Girls Pole Vault (3.11m). Marc Jones, Colaiste Muire Cobh also won gold in the 100m Non-Scoring race on the day with a time of 11.32.

 Munster had <u>6</u> representatives (up two from 2017) (Laura Frawley, St. Mary's Charleville, Katie Nolke, Ursuline Waterford, Dillon Ryan, Thurles CBS, Harry Nevin, St. Francis College, Rochestown, Wymin Sivakumar, Colaiste an Spioraid Naoimh & Diarmuid O'Connor, Colaiste Choilm Ballincollig) on the Irish team for the Schools Combined Events International in Glasgow in November 2018. Munster athletes, Laura Frawley & Harry Nevin were Ireland's only individual medal winners with both winning silver in the Junior competitions.

From a National perspective, some of our highlights were: -

At the National Indoor Championships in March a total of **141** individual medals were won by Munster (**63** gold, **44 silver & 34 bronze**) with **6** National records also set & one equalled.

- A total of **219** individual medals were won by Munster athletes at the National Juvenile T&F Championships in July. This comprised **96 gold medals**, **63 silver medals 60 bronze medals & 9 new National records were set and 1 equalled.**
- 2018 has been another hugely successful year for Munster Schools Athletics with our athletes excelling on national & international teams throughout the year in a wide range of events winning a total of <u>6</u> individual international medals (4 silver & 2 bronze) <u>3 out of 8</u> of the Irish Schools Cups at the Irish Life Health T&F Championships, <u>51</u> Irish Schools titles over T&F and Cross Country (46 T&F, 1 XC & 4 CE) & <u>36</u> Tailteann medals (13 gold, 14 silver & 9 bronze) together with the <u>Girls Tailteann Trophy</u>. Munster athletes also set <u>12</u> Munster T&F records and <u>1</u> Irish School records over the year.
- Juvenile Combined Events continues to be a strength in Munster with the province featuring strongly on the National stage again this year. Our athletes won <u>12</u> medals in total 5 gold, 4 silver & 3 bronze at the National Indoor Championships in January 2018 with two new CPB's set by Brian Lynch, Old Abbey A.C. & Harry Nevin, Leevale A.C. & had 8 wins in total (4 gold, 3 silver & 1 bronze) at the National Outdoor Combined Events in May with a new CBP set by Ava Rochford, Ennis Track A.C. in the Girls U/14 plus a new National U/14 High Jump record of 1.63m.
- At the Irish Life Health National Juvenile Even Age Cross Country Championships in Abbotstown, Munster athletes won 20 individual medals in total with fantastic races from our three athletes who won gold & National titles on the day Nicole Dinan, Leevale A.C. Girls U/14, Aimee Hayde, Newport A.C. Girls U/16 & Dean Casey, Ennis Track A.C. Boys U/16. Other athletes who produced great performances & scored a top 3 finish were Louise O'Mahony, B.M.O.H. A.C. (3<sup>rd</sup> Girls U/14) & Lucy Holmes, West Waterford A.C. (3<sup>rd</sup> Girls U/18).
- The Irish Life Health National Juvenile Uneven Age Cross Country Championships took place in Navan Adventure Centre, Navan Racecourse on Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> December. Munster athletes won **35** individual medals in total with fantastic races from our four athletes who won gold & National titles on the day Nicole Dinan, Leevale A.C. Girls U/13, Shane Buckley, Dundrum A.C., Boys U/13, Emma Landers, Youghal A.C. Girls U/15 & Aimee Hayde, Newport A.C. Girls U/17. Other athletes who produced great performances & scored a top 3 finish were Eabha Nic Chonaola West Muskerry A.C 3<sup>rd</sup> Girls U/11, Luke Merrigan, Kenmare A.C. 3<sup>rd</sup> Boys U/11, Ava Fitzgerald, Carrig na BhFear AC. 3<sup>rd</sup> Girls U/13, Lucy Holmes, West Waterford A.C. 2<sup>nd</sup> Girls U/17, Paul Hartnett, Midleton A.C. 2<sup>nd</sup> Boys U/17 & Orla O'Connor, Waterford A.C. 2<sup>nd</sup> Girls U/19.
- At the National Juvenile Team Games, there were **34** sets of team medals won by Munster (16 gold, 7 silver and 11 bronze) which well exceeded the 23 sets of medals won last year. In addition to this, Munster Clubs also took home **12** sets of Relay medals (6 gold & 3 silver & 3 bronze).
- In 2018, Munster athletes continued to participate in great numbers at the National Juvenile "B" Track & Field Championships in Tullamore in July winning **35** individual medals in total (14 gold, 11 silver & 10 bronze) in the "B" Championships. Our record breaker on the day was **Masie McRae**, **Midleton A.C**. who jumped 4.16m in the Girls U/12 Long Jump to win gold. In the Irish Life Health National Juvenile Club Relays, Munster teams came home with 24 sets of medals (10 gold, 7 silver & 7 bronze).
- At National Juvenile "B" Cross Country Championships in Clarinbridge, Co. Galway on Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> February 2018, Munster athletes recorded 3 gold medal wins by Faye O'Riordan, Carraig na BhFear A.C. in the Girls U/11, Alex Coughlan, Doheny A.C. in the Boys U/11 & Colm Gillespie, West Muskerry A.C., A silver medal was won by Dara Sheehy, Bantry A.C. (Boys U/11), with bronze medals for Kathryn Ryan, Killarney Valley A.C. (Girls U/11), Cal Tutty, West Waterford A.C. (Boys U/11), Con Willans, West Waterford A.C. (Boys U/13) & Connor O'Neill, West Muskerry A.C. (Boys U/15). Cork came out top in the Inter-County competition with 5

gold & 3 silver with **Waterford** winning 1 gold, 2 silver & 2 bronze & **Clare** taking home 1 gold, 2 silver & 1 bronze.

# Gold & National Records for Lynch & Nevin



Munster athletes competed strongly at the Irish Life Health National Combined Events Championships in AIT Arena, Athlone on Saturday 20th January 2018 taking home **12** medals in total (5 gold, 4 silver & 3 bronze). In the Youth Men's competition, **Brian Lynch**, **Old Abbey A.C.** won gold in a Championship Best Performance of 3499 points with **Harry Nevin**, **Leevale A.C.** also winning gold in a Championship Best Performance of 3349 points in the Boys U/15 competition with gold medals & National titles also won by **William Bello**, **Ennis Track A.C.** (Boys U/14), **Ava Rochford**, **Ennis Track A.C.** (Girls U/14), **Laura Frawley**, **St. Mary's A.C. Limerick** (Girls U/15).



**Ava Rochford, Ennis Track A.C.** was 1<sup>st</sup> in the Girls U/14 competition with a score of 2983 points with **Kate Naughton, Leevale A.C.** in 4<sup>th</sup> place on 2037 points. In the Girls U/15 competition, **Laura Frawley, St. Mary's A.C. Limerick** won gold with 3123 points with **Emily Wall, Leevale A.C.** taking silver in the Girls U/16 with 2637 points. **Emily O'Mahony, Waterford A.C.** won bronze in the Youth Women's competition on 2745 points with bronze also for **Katie Walsh, Carraig na BhFear A.C.** (2886 points).





William Bello, Ennis Track A.C. took gold in the Boys U/15 competition finishing on 2209 points with silver for Kyle Ettoh, Leevale A.C. (2163 points) & 4<sup>th</sup> place for George Alamu, Midleton A.C. (2042 points). Harry Nevin, Leevale A.C. won the Boys U/15 competition with a new National record of 3349 points with his team-mate Colin Murphy placing 4<sup>th</sup> with 1994 points and Alex Reynolds, Nenagh Olympic A.C. in 5<sup>th</sup> (1933 points). In the Boys U/16 competition, Jordan Kissane, Tralee Harriers A.C. won silver on 2983 points while in the Youth Men's competition there was gold and a CBP for Brian Lynch, Old Abbey A.C. (3499 points), silver for Darragh Miniter, St. Mary's A.C. Clare (3458 points), bronze for Cillian Griffin, Tralee Harriers A.C. (2847 points) & 4<sup>th</sup> place for Tristan Chambers, Bandon A.C. (2530 points).



## **<u>3 Munster Indoor Relay Records Set</u>**



The Munster Juvenile Indoor Relays took place on Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> January 2018 in Nenagh Indoor Stadium. Top Club on the day was **Dooneen A.C.** who won 19 sets of medals in total (10 gold & 3 silver & 6 bronze) with **Leevale A.C** next with 10 sets of medals (5 gold, 4 silver & 1 bronze) & two Championship Best Performances in the Boys U/11 4 x 100m (59.19) & Boys U/17 4 x 200m (1.35.55) & **Nenagh Olympic A.C.** in 3<sup>rd</sup> place with 6 sets of medals (1 gold, 4 silver & 1 bronze). Details of records set on the day are below:-

- 1. Leevale A.C. Boys U/11 4 x 100m team ran 59.19 to better the existing record of 59.90 set by Waterford A.C. in 2013.
- 2. Leevale A.C. Boys U/17 4 x 200m team ran 1.35.55 to smash the existing record of 1.38.20 set by their own Club in 2014.
- 3. **Ferrybank A.C.** Girls U/19 4 x 200m team ran 1.47.51 to better the time of 1.48.78 set by Belgooly A.C. in 2004.

## National Juvenile "B" XC Gold for For Munster Athletes







# Super Silver for Sophie @ European U18 T&F Championships



The European U/18 Track & Field Championships took place in Gyor, Hungary from 5<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> July 2018. <u>6</u> athletes represented Munster on the Irish team – Ciara Kennelly, Killarney Valley A.C. (High Jump), Sophie Meredith, St. Mary's A.C. Limerick (Long Jump), Miriam Daly, Carrick-On-Suir A.C. (400mH), Sophie O'Sullivan, Ballymore Cobh A.C. (800m), Brian Lynch, Old Abbey A.C. (Decathlon) & Conor Morey, Leevale A.C. (100m).

Our only medal winner was **Sophie O'Sullivan** who won a super silver medal in the 800m. Having easily progressed through her heat in 2.12.33 and Semi-Final in 2.07.95, O'Sullivan went on to win silver in 2.06.05 behind GB athlete Keely Hodgkinson who won in a new CR of 2.04.84. Miriam Daly, Carrick-On-Suir A.C. placed 4<sup>th</sup> in her 400mH heat in a time of 1.01.66 and placed 6<sup>th</sup> in the Semi-Final in a personal best of 1.01.35 finishing 10th overall. In the Boys Decathlon, Brian Lynch, Old Abbey A.C. finished in 26<sup>th</sup> place overall scoring a personal best of 6,306 points and posting 3 new personal bests in the 100m (11.61), Long Jump (6.74m) & Pole Vault (3.60m). Conor Morey, Leevale A.C. finished 4<sup>th</sup> in his heat in 11.05 advancing as the fastest qualifier to the Semi-Final. There was a false start in his SF but a late recall gun saw him and some of the others run a full race. It was subsequently rerun 10 minutes later where he placed 6<sup>th</sup> in 11.17, evidently tired having run two 100m races in guick succession. In the field events, Sophie Meredith, St. Mary's Limerick finished in 15<sup>th</sup> place in the Long Jump qualification round with a best of 5.79m which unfortunately was just 9 cm short of the mark of progress to the Final. Ciara Kennelly, Killarney Valley **A.C.** jumped 1.68m in the qualification round of the High Jump to finish joint 10<sup>th</sup> and short of the 1.77m qualification mark. Congratulations to all on competing so well at such a high level.



## Superb Silver for Irish Women's 4 x 100m Team



The World U/20 T&F Championships took place in Tampere, Finland from 10<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> July 2018. <u>5</u> athletes were selected to represent Munster on the Irish team with **Ciara Neville**, **Emerald A.C.** winning a silver medal as part of the Irish Women's 4 x 100m Relay team. The Munster team selected was **Ciara Neville**, **Emerald A.C.** (100m, 200m & 4 x 100m), Conor **Morey**, Leevale A.C. (4 x 100m), Darragh McElhinney, Bantry A.C. (5km), Jo Keane, Ennis Track A.C. (800m) & Orla O'Connor, Waterford A.C. (10km Walk).

**Ciara Neville, Emerald A.C.** competed in the 100m and 200m as well as the 4 x 100m relay final. In the 100m, she gave an excellent account of herself running her 2<sup>nd</sup> fastest time ever of 11.54 to finish 2<sup>nd</sup> in her heat. In the semi-final, she finished 5<sup>th</sup> in a time of 11.70 to leave her with an overall ranking of 16<sup>th</sup> on the world stage. She was also 4<sup>th</sup> in her 200m heat in a time of 24.01 and 8<sup>th</sup> in her semi-final in 24.68. **Jo Keane, Ennis Track A.C.** ran 2.09.59 in her 800m heat to progress to the semi-final where she ran a pb of 2.06.91 to finish 5<sup>th</sup>, just outside qualifying for the final. **Conor Morey, Leevale A.C.** competed in the Men's 4 x 100m Relay where the Irish team finished 3<sup>rd</sup> in their heat and 11<sup>th</sup> overall in 40.51. **Darragh McElhinney, Bantry A.C.** finished 18<sup>th</sup> in the 5km in a time of 14.53.63 with **Orla O'Connor, Waterford A.C.** finishing 14<sup>th</sup> in the 10km Walk in a time of 47.55.40, a new Irish U/20 record. Our best result was the superb silver medal won by the Irish Women's 4 x 100m relay team. The Irish women's 4x100m relay team made history by winning silver medals in a new national U20 record of 43.90 seconds. The quartet of Molly Scott (SLOT), Gina Akpe-Moses (Blackrock-Louth), **Ciara Neville (Emerald)** and Patience Jumbo-Gula (St Gerard's Dundalk) struck silver narrowly behind the Germans who ran 43.82 with Great Britain and

Northern Ireland third in 44.05. Rhasidat Adeleke (Tallaght) had a hamstring injury which prevented her from making the final, but it was superlative performance nonetheless. Scott, Akpe-Moses and **Neville** have been on countless relay teams together down through the years and reaped their rewards on the grandest stage.








Irish Schools Combined Events



The Irish Team won two individual silver medals (both won by Munster athletes) as well as silver team medals in the U16 Boys and Over 16 Girls & bronze team medals in the U16 Girls and Over 16 Boys.





Munster had <u>6</u> representatives on the Irish team with our best performances coming from Laura Frawley, St. Mary's SC Charleville who won individual silver in the U16 Girls competition finishing on 3328 points and Harry Nevin, St. Francis' College Rochestown who also won individual silver in the U16 Boys competition with 3294 points.

**Laura Frawley** led the Irish U16 Girls' team to a bronze medal finish with **Katie Nolke, Ursuline Waterford** in 10<sup>th</sup> place (3066 points) and 2<sup>nd</sup> scorer for the Irish team which finished on 9418 points behind Scotland in 2<sup>nd</sup> (9456 points) & England in gold medal position (9761 points).

**Harry Nevin** led the Irish U16 Boys' team to silver ably assisted by **Dillon Ryan, Thurles CBS** who was 8<sup>th</sup> with 2930 points making them 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> scorers for the Irish team.
